## Employment Retention Bonus through the Prevention, Retention, and Contingency Plan

- ◆ The Hancock County PRC plan has a work support service for job retention at new employment.
- ◆ Persons with **new** employment (permanent placement) of 30 or more hours per week can apply for a Job Retention bonus.
- ◆ After 3 consecutive months of employment the employee may be eligible to receive a \$250 retention bonus through our agency. After 6 months of continuous employment the employee may be eligible to receive another \$250 retention bonus.
- ◆ Employees must be in good standing with the employer at the 3 and 6 month bonus issuance.
- ◆ Applications for the Job Retention Bonus must be made within 30 days of the first day of work.
- ◆ Income eligibility will be based on the 30 day period prior to the start of the new employment and must be under 200% FPL.
- ◆ Interested persons should visit OhioMeansJobs-Hancock County to complete an application, meet with a case worker and provide verifications to verify eligibility. Ongoing cooperation with OMJ staff is necessary for retention bonuses.
