## **Transportation Assistance through the Prevention, Retention, and Contingency Plan**

- ◇ 90 days transportation directly related to employment
  - Gas Cards—Can be approved for someone driving themselves to work or can be approved for someone that provides rides back and forth to work for the applicant. Individual receiving the gas card must have a valid driver's license, proof of current vehicle insurance, and proof of current registration.
- ◇ Cab Service
  - Available all shifts
- ◇ Hancock Hardin Wyandot Putnam Community Action Commission (HHWP-CAC) HATS
  - Available until midnight Monday—Friday

\*Issued in 30 day increments. The agency must verify with employer every 30 days to confirm employment is ongoing and the number of scheduled work days remain the same.

- ◇ Driver's Education Classes (limited to one per lifetime)
- ◇ Car Seats may be included to ensure safe transportation of children to daycare providers.
- ◇ Income eligibility will be based on the 30 day period prior to the application filing and must be under 200% FPL.
- ◇ Interested persons should visit OhioMeansJobs-Hancock County to complete an application, meet with a case worker and provide verifications to verify eligibility. Ongoing cooperation with OMJ staff is necessary for transportation assistance.
